The assignment number can be found in the admission document or licence, or if necessary can be requested from a regional office dealing with amateur radio administration. **The usage provisions of Order No. 36/2006, amended with Order 69/2007 and published on page 4729 of the Official Gazette of the Federal Network Agency No. 24/2007 of 19 December 2007 apply.** Information on this is also available at <http://www.bundesnetzagentur.de/amateurfunk>.

For radio operations in line with CEPT T/R 61-01, the home call sign visible on the T/R 61-01 permissible foreign licence is to be entered in the field "Class A call sign assigned" and preceded with the prefix "DL/". The T/R 61-01 does not apply to amateur radio operators resident in Germany or who hold a permanent German admission to participation in the amateur service.
